
EARLY ACTION APPLICATION NUMBERS

James Madison University is experiencing a historic increase in applications from the Class of 2028. Early Action decisions were posted by JMU's Office of Admissions on Tuesday, January 23—beginning another exciting season for new Dukes.

JMU received 26,935 Early Action applications before the November 1 deadline, a 7% increase from last year. We received early action applications from 48 states, US territories, and many other countries.

Our goal continues to be to admit students that we believe are academically prepared for the rigors of a JMU education. The quality of the early applicant pool was very strong this year, and we were able to offer admission to approximately 75% of Early Action applicants, admitting 70% of the in-state applicants, which is up from 67% last year.

We look forward to sharing additional insights on the entire applicant pool as that information becomes available.

HONORS COLLEGE UPDATE

The JMU Honors College is also experiencing an increase in applications this year. They had over 2,400 Early Action applicants and around 250 Regular Decision applicants. EA decisions were posted at the end of January and RD decisions are expected in mid/late-March.

MAJOR SPOTLIGHT: NEW CONCENTRATION OPTION IN INFORMATION AND CYBERSECURITY MANAGEMENT

We're excited to share that the Computer Information Systems major at JMU's College of Business is now offering a new concentration in Information and Cybersecurity Management. This program is designed to equip the next generation of information systems and cybersecurity professionals with crucial and marketable skills in safeguarding information systems.



In this concentration, students gain a comprehensive understanding of how to identify and mitigate cybersecurity threats, assess risks, and ensure the protection of data and systems. It's an education that combines theoretical knowledge with practical, hands-on experience, preparing students for a range of critical roles in the information systems and cybersecurity fields. Potential career paths include consulting, information security analysis, incident response, risk and vulnerability analysis, computer forensics, and more.

Students can also get involved in the Association for Information Systems, a local student chapter of a respected information systems society, where they can develop their professional skills and leadership abilities while building lifelong connections with industry professionals and peers with similar career goals. Additionally, JMU is proudly hosting the AIS Student Leadership Conference in 2026, an international event that promises to be a cornerstone for future leaders in the field.

This new concentration will be a significant addition to the academic journey of students passionate about cybersecurity and information systems. If you know students interested in this area, JMU may be a good fit.
